1. WeatherNet Classroom	Hunt Elementary	446	\$5,000.00	This grant is for the purchase of a WeatherNet. The data collected from the WeatherNet device will help students track weather patterns and prepare daily forecasts transmitted to News 4 - San Antonio.
2. Classroom Jeopardy!	Cuero Jr. High School	152	\$553.83	This request is for the purchase of Classroom Jeopardy, a game format which makes history more interesting by using the different learning modalities in review for TEKS.
3. Hallway To Literacy	John C. French Elementary	100+	\$4,220.00	This grant will provide books in the hall for all Pre-K students at this campus to read morning and afternoon at John C. French Elementary.
4. Measuring Matters With Probe Ware	Cuero Jr. High School	160	\$4,900.00	This grant will provide probe ware to collect data intensely so that students can analyze scientific data quickly at higher levels of cognition including PH levels and temperatures. Junior High students are now required to spend 60% of their time in a lab setting.
5. Cuero ISD Virtual Tours	Cuero High School	35+	\$2,500.00	This project is a request for a camcorder, digital camera and other accessories to film virtual tours of the school and community to be placed on the website www.cueroisd.org .
6. Cuero Junior High Daily School News Video	Cuero Jr. High School	475	\$2,500.00	This was for the purchase of a camcorder, laptop and camera accessories to implement a new school news video program for Cuero Junior High School.
7. Campus Beautification Association	Cuero Jr. High School	30	\$953.36	This grant will provide funding for basic equipment and plants for at-risk students to use and plant after school on campus in order to provide activity as research shows that a large percentage of teenage crime occurs within one hour after school.
8. Rocketry: A Key To The Future	Cuero High School	120	\$1,000.00	This grant is for students to build and launch a rocket to gather scientific data for flight data and theoretical calculations for 9 th grade students.
9. Centering on Success	Hunt Elementary	25	\$987.43	This grant purchased Smart Center guided reading books individualized to help special needs students master IEP's.
10. Ocean In Motion	Hunt Elementary	446	\$1,700.00	This is for the rental of a 48-foot van which houses 5 modules of activities about the Gulf of Mexico and its conservation of living organisms, to be located in Cuero.
11. Microscopic World of Microorganisms	Cuero Jr. High School	160	\$4,300.00	This grant was for the purchase of 6 microscopes, a projector and computer for the purpose of 6 th , 7 th , and 8 th grade students using their own scientific creations and discoveries to create slide shows and movie clips and to share their discoveries with the class.

Exploring Visual Communication with Pinhole Camera Photography	Cuero Jr. High School	150	\$1,000.00	This grant was for the purchase of a scanner and a digital camera so all 7 th and 8 th grade art students can create a pinhole camera from an oatmeal box in order to explore visual communication in photography.
