3. Learning Through Visual Presentation	Intermediate	4 <sup>th</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup>	2,500.00	This project will provide hands on materials at the Intermediate campus for those students needing visual / kinesthetic representations of lessons. None of these materials are available at this time.
4. Let's Add Some Spice	Intermediate 6 <sup>th</sup> Grade	6 <sup>th</sup>	2,500.00	This project will provide manipulative materials / technology for the sixth grade math program to teach brand new TAKS material, previously not taught at sixth grade level.
5. Math Counts	John C. French	PreK - K	4,000.00	This project will set up a math lab in a spare classroom with a variety of high-interest Math manipulative materials, Math literature and games to enhance PreK / K classrooms.
