1. Play With A Purpose	John C. French	94	\$4,449.00	This grant is for developing an outdoor discovery area for students in Pre-K, PPCD, and EMC for developing gross motor and core curriculum skills.
2. The Better To See With My Dear	Cuero Jr. High	435	\$1,200.00	This grant will add a few quality eye pieces of varying powers to allow students to peer through the 17.5" Dobsonian telescope so that the full potential of the telescope will be realized.
3. Integration Of Biology and IPC TEKS	Cuero High School	673	\$1,500.00	This grant seeks to integrate and reinforce TEKS of Biology and IPC and is targeted to students experiencing difficulties with TAKS. This integration does not exist in current texts and study guides.
4. SMARTBoard Interactive Whiteboard	Cuero Jr. High	290	\$1,763.00	This project will fund a smartboard that allows tutors to access and display information from the internet, run live video from a camera, deliver CD-ROM presentations, and control software from a single location.
5. United Streaming Goes Live	District-Wide	1950	\$4,750.00	This grant will provide a digital video library that will empower teachers to incorporate over 40,000 video clips into multi-media presentations. It is ideal for project and inquiry-based learning.
6. Immersion In Technology Using a SmartBoard	Cuero Jr. High	150	\$1,763.00	This grant provides for an additional smartboard to be used in the computer lab at the new Cuero Jr. High so that both grades 7 th & 8 th will have a smartboard.
7. Team Cuero Science Extravaganza & Outreach Programs (Texas State Aquarium)	District-Wide	1950	\$2,800.00	This project will bring the Texas State Aquarium Outreach Program to Cuero ISD so that students from Pre-K through 12 will have the opportunity to experience quality science programs at a fraction of the cost of on-sight field trips.
8. Read Naturally Reading Lab	Hunt Elementary & Jr. High	600	\$4,488.00	This grant will fund a "Read Naturally" lab for students in grades 2 through 6, which will include the new intermediate campus. It will incorporate research-based strategies to provide additional fluency support to maximize students' fluency development.

9. Smart Technology	District-Wide	1950	\$3,526.00	This grant provides for three additional smartboards to be purchased for the new intermediate campus and Cuero High School to help energize presentations and engage students in the learning process.
10. Reading / Writing Connections Library	Hunt Elementary	456	\$4,800.00	This project will provide Hunt Elementary with a multi-functioning classroom "Connections" library so that students will have books accessible on a daily basis.
11. Get Hooked on Success	Cuero High School Freshman	175	\$1,921.40	This project will fund a two-day summer camp for incoming freshman students at Cuero ISD. A Houston University recreational team will teach and promote teamwork and building relationships.
12. SMARTBoard for a Smart Today & Tomorrow	Cuero Jr. High	275	\$1,763.00	This grant will provide an additional smartboard for the new intermediate campus so that each grade level will have access to integrate more digital and interactive resources into the lessons.
13. ELMO Is Not Just For Sesame Street	Cuero Jr. High	435	\$5,000.00	This grant will provide for the ELMO or Externally Loaded Media Object which is a piece of technology that helps students see their work from their classroom world so that media can be easily worked by a large group. It will be placed at the new intermediate campus.
