1. Get Hooked on Success 2008	Cuero High School	Freshman	\$2,209.00	This project will provide a 2 day summer camp for incoming Freshman to address beliefs, attitudes and behaviors regarding drugs, alcohol, and other decisions.
2. Lend A Helping Hand	Project REAP	District	\$500.00	This grant will provide clothing and other supplies to students to keep them in school. These funds are not available via other grants or local funds.
3. Science Camp	High School & Jr. High School	6-12 <sup>th</sup> Science/Math Students	\$5,000.00	This project will "scale up" physics experiments and allow real-life and hands-on participation of students when dealing with TAKS formulas and math.
4. Libraries, Lessons, and Lifelong Learning	John C. French	PPCD, EMC, Pre-K, and K	\$4,050.00	This project will provide students with innovative, stimulating authors storytellers, puppeteers and performing artist to perform a monthly basis to students thereby inspiring them to become writers and lifelong readers.
5. i-test with -ipods	Cuero High School	9 <sup>th</sup> -12 <sup>th</sup>	\$4,993.87	This grant will enhance teaching through the use of i-pods. Teachers will upload lessons and exams onto the small listening device and will allow students to listen to the information as often as needed to increase retention of material.
6. Gobbler Tube	All Campuses	Pre-K – 12th	\$4,373.85	This project will provide on-demand training videos created by teachers and local staff personnel to students in grades Pre-K through 12 <sup>th</sup> .
7. Power to the Students with Smart Board	Cuero High School	10th	\$1,399.00	This grant will provide a Smartboard for the Cuero High School's World History classes to be used to integrate more digital and interactive resources into the lessons.
8. Motivating Students with Clickers and Jeopardy	Cuero High School	9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup>	\$3,645.00	This project is for an interactive student's response system for the subject of social studies. Wireless response devices will engage every student in the classroom. Classroom Jeopardy will review, engage, and challenge all students in an innovative way.

Smart Board Interactive Whiteboard	Cuero Intermediate School	4 <sup>th</sup>	\$1,399.00	This grant will provide an interactive whiteboard that allows the teacher to access and display information from the Internet, run live video from a camera, deliver CD-Rom presentations and control software from a single location.
10. 21 <sup>st</sup> Century Media Mania	Cuero Jr. High School	7 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup>	\$4,852.60	This project will provide today's technology of innovative learning through the use of portable media players which will reach all types of learning styles including textual, auditory and visual.
11. Give Them A Hand To Their Goals	Cuero Intermediate School	4 <sup>th</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup>	\$485.27	This grant will provide incentives to students and provide them with visible, daily reminders to remind them of what awesome readers they are.

Clicking Right Along: Bringing More Technology Into the Classroom	Cuero Intermediate School	6 <sup>th</sup>	\$3,428.00	This request is for the purchase of a Classroom Performance System (CPS) to promote active participation of all students and involvement. It will also provide the instructor with instant feedback from students.
13. Singing Scientists	Cuero Intermediate School	5 <sup>th</sup>	\$236.90	This project uses instructional music to actively engage students in the lessons of Science (physical, life and earth science) by using songs to enrich understanding of key scientific concepts.
14. The Texas Zoo	Cuero Intermediate School	4 <sup>th</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup>	\$960.00	This project will allow the Texas Zoo to present an interactive animal program to all students which incorporates Science TEKS.
15. Classroom Performance System	Cuero High School	9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup>	\$3,020.00	This grant will provide the math department with a CPS system that will provide teachers with immediate feedback on individual student understanding of math objectives during a large group instruction.
16. Smart Technology in the Classroom	Cuero Junior High School	8 <sup>th</sup>	\$1,399.00	This grant will provide the English/Language Arts with an interactive whiteboard that will aid in constructing creative and exciting lessons to which students will respond positively.
17. CPS Empowered Classroom	Cuero High School	9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup>	\$3,020.00	This project will provide the Spanish department with a CPS empowered classroom that will provide the quantitative tools to influence the processing of questions and formulation of answers by the student in a non-threatening and positive manner.
18. Make it 'Wright' Again and Again	John C. French	Kindergarten	\$4,590.00	This grant will provide teachers with decodable books to positively engage students in the reading process and will promote students' reading independence.

French, Hunt Elem., & Intermediate School	Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup>	\$2,500.00	This project will provide school assemblies by the Knights of the Guild Adventures in Character which will reinforce positive character traits, life skills, anti-violence/substance abuse awareness, and self-esteem concepts.
