3. Get Hooked on Success 2009	Cuero High School	\$2500.70	This project will provide a 2 day summer camp for incoming Freshman to address beliefs, attitudes and behaviors regarding drugs, alcohol, and other decisions.
4. Read – Read - Read	Cuero Jr. High School	\$500.00	This project is for purchasing newly released library books to spark interest and expand Accelerated Reading options.
5. “Go Green” Cuero Science Extravaganza	District-Wide	\$4000.00	This project focuses on ecology/environment/alternative energy with many agencies to provide interactive activities for students at all campuses.
6. Building Up the Foundation	Cuero Jr. High & Cuero Intermediate	\$2051.50	This project will help build up the students’ lungs through purchasing equipment not available at Cuero ISD such as dumbbells, chin-up bars, latex-free bands for flexibility and strength.
