Grant	Campus	Amount Funded	Comments
1. Don't Feed the Bully	Cuero Intermediate School	\$5000.00	Bullying including "cyber bullying" (done by cell phone text and Internet) has become a big problem. This proposal includes a video conferencing, campus presentation, and student study books for bullying intervention.
2. L.I.B.rary Project Learning in Beat	Cuero High School	\$1210.00	This project is for purchasing a sound system for the CHS library to enhance the learning environment and make it "student friendly."
3. Get Hooked on Success 2010	Cuero High School	\$2051.32	This project will provide a 2 day summer camp for incoming Freshman to address beliefs, attitudes and behaviors regarding drugs, alcohol, and other decisions.
4. Lend A Helping Hand	District-Wide	\$1500.00	This project will provide clothing and other supplies to students to keep them in school. These funds are not available via other grants or funds.
5. The Pulse of the Classroom	Cuero Jr. High School	\$4902.00	This grant will provide the math department with a CPS system that will provide teachers with immediate feedback on individual student understanding of math objectives during a large group instruction.
6. Gobbler P.R.I.D.E. Days	Cuero High School	\$5000.00	This proposal would provide a two day expo of keynote speakers, mini-sessions, and personal contacts with businesses and community leaders to instill values students may not receive elsewhere. All sessions would be related to PRIDE - Perseverance, Responsibility, Integrity, Discipline, and Excellence.
7. The Babbage Project: Laptops for Students	Cuero High School	\$5000.00	This project is for the purchase of 10 laptops to be checked out by students contingent on CHS offering programming courses next year in JAVA, COBALT, and building video games.
8. World of Engineering Day at CHS	Cuero High School	\$1000.00	CHS will provide the additional \$292 if project is approved. This project is for the purchase of balsa wood race cars, rocketry kits, rockets, and other materials for complex physics projects at CHS.
9. Culinary Presentation by Molly Fowler	Cuero High School	\$800.00	This project includes a culinary presentation by a professional chef on site to enable FCS students to become aware of the aspects of a career in food service.
10. Getting Interactive with WhiteBoards	Hunt Elementary	\$4800.00	This grant will provide Smartboards for the Hunt Elementary 2 nd Grade classes to be used to integrate more digital and interactive resources into the lessons. This grade level does not have any SmartBoards to utilize currently.

11. Interactive WhiteBoards – An Engaging Experience	Hunt Elementary	\$2680.00	This grant will provide SmartBoards for the Hunt Elementary 3 rd Grade classes to be used to integrate more digital and interactive resources into the lessons. This grade level currently has 2 SmartBoards.
12. After-Hours Vocational Workforce Readiness	Cuero High School & Project SHARP Adult Family Members	\$4000.00	This project is to build a testing library, the first of its kind in our area to allow individuals to utilize trade books to “test out” and receive certification in technical trade areas where needed. It will also provide an opportunity for eligible SHARP students and family members to achieve certification in the National Center for Construction Education and Research Core Curriculum and offers an additional field of study in Millwright.
13. Video Projects to ‘Flip’ Over!	Cuero Jr. High School	\$914.95	This proposal is for 6 simple plug & play video recorders that will be utilized by students to develop multimedia projects via a camcorder.
14. A Sea of Knowledge	Cuero Jr. High School	\$3500.00	This project is for the purchase of an entire ecosystem (aquarium and other aquatic materials) for students to utilize to practice scientific skills.
15. Books are Child’s Play	Cuero Jr. High School	\$2683.00	This project provides Play-away digital audio books targeting ESL students to improve reading and listening skills.
