The purpose of this grant is to provide science instruction for all Hunt Elementary students by establishing raised bed vegetable gardens. The raised beds will be planted, maintained and harvested by Junior Master Gardener Club members, but will be accessible to all Hunt students and faculty to observe, measure and enjoy. Immersing students in gardening allows them to use their science and math skills in real world situations and solidifies the abstract concepts from the classroom into concrete skills in the garden.

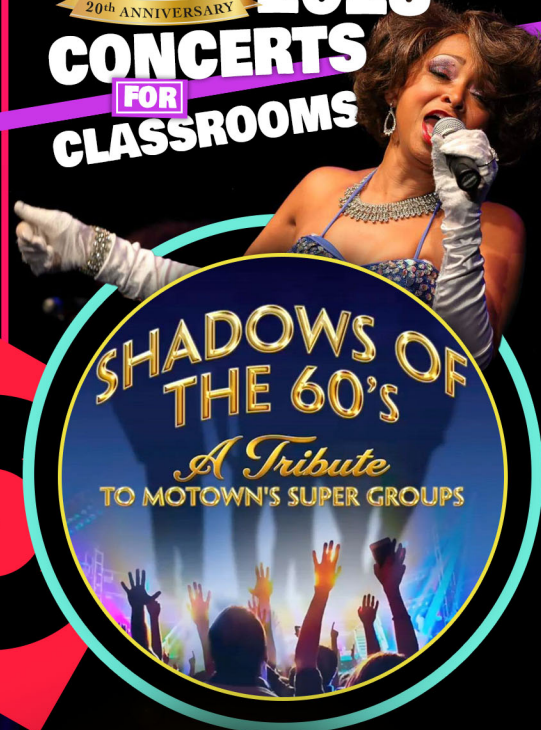

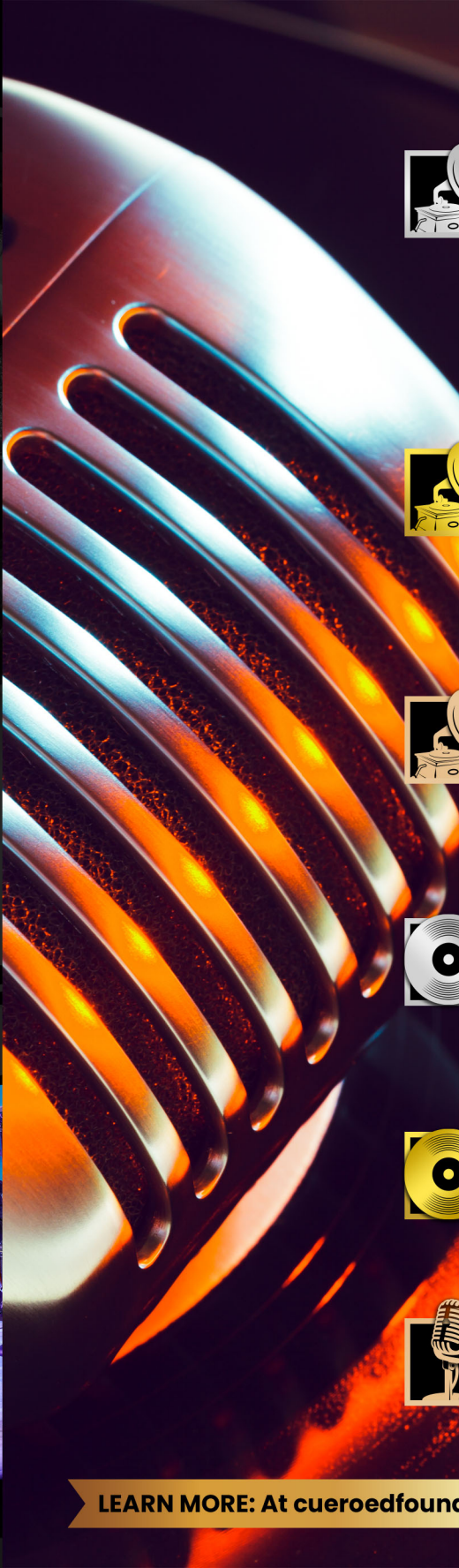

An Enduring Legacy

Thank you for your donations to the Foundation's Enduring Legacy campaign. As the name suggests, the Enduring Legacy campaign continues.

A portion of campaign funds raised in 2022 were used to make enhancements to the CISD Performing Arts Center, including an improved sound system and a state-of-the-art projector. The digital scenery projector makes the stage come alive using licensed projected backdrops for theater productions.
