



Phil Jackson Memorial Scholarship

Philip Randall Jackson, known by his friends as Phil, graduated from Cuero High School in 1966 and the University of Texas College of Pharmacy in 1972. He was an avid outdoorsman, rancher, and pharmacist who owned and operated two pharmacies in the Houston Medical Center. Though he made his home in Houston with his wife, Mima, he faithfully and tirelessly served on the Cuero ISD Education Foundation board of directors from August of 2003 until his death in July of 2015. To honor his memory, the Cuero ISD Education Foundation board of directors established the Phil Jackson Memorial Scholarship, which provides eligible Cuero High School students with the financial resources necessary to participate in dual-credit and dual-enrollment courses.
