Carting For Success: Pure Joy Coffee Cart	CJHS, CHS	\$1,100.00	The purpose of this grant is to provide special needs students at CHS with the opportunity to develop and practice employability skills including socialization, communication, inventory counting, and money math through the development of a small business. Teachers and staff at CHS will be able to purchase items such as coffee, bottled water, and snacks at the Pure Joy Coffee Cart.
Coding in the Classroom	JCF, Hunt, CJHS, CHS	\$6,225.98	Coding is the language of the future, but it is difficult to learn without hands-on experiences. This grant will provide students at every campus the opportunity to learn the basics of coding, run code, and see it come to life. Students' logic/problem solving skills will be enhanced in the process. When students receive error messages, they will be challenged to debug the issues and recompile the code in a continuous loop of learning.
Extending the Art Classroom Into Real Life Experiences	CJHS	\$2,214.00	The purpose of this grant is to provide Art II students at CJHS the opportunity to learn from artisans using mediums and equipment not available to them on campus. Students will travel to Luling and Wimberley to interact with potters and glass blowers, respectively, participate in demonstrations, and receive hands-on instruction, resulting in the development of their own pieces.
Lend A Helping Hand	JCF, Hunt, CJHS, CHS	\$2,000.00	When possible, the Cuero ISD Student Services Department assists CISD students whose families are struggling economically and are unable to provide their children with the necessary items to succeed in school. This grant will enable the department to assist families in need with necessities such as school supplies, dresscode-approved clothing, haircuts, glasses, and medical assistance.
Makey Makey-ing Interactive Board Games	CHS	\$1,438.96	The purpose of this grant is to introduce CHS students to coding in the context of game design. Students will be challenged to come up with a game concept, present the concept for approval, create a prototype, and play test it. Students will then create their final board games using the Makey Makeys and Chromebooks, and the final play test will be at the CHS library's Magical Monday where community members will be invited to play the games.
Mobile Planetarium: Bringing Science to Schools	Hunt	\$1,890.00	Students will journey through the solar system when they step into a mobile planetarium courtesy of this grant. Students will be guided through the stars of the northern hemisphere exactly as they appear on the day of the presentation and will also witness the night sky in different seasons and from different perspectives.
Projecting Into the Future: Technology in Theatre	CJHS, CHS	\$4,879.62	The purpose of this grant is to help CJHS and CHS theatre students stay competitive at One Act Play contests by enhancing the visuals to their performances through the use of a large screen projector.
Rolling in Style: Wagons for Special Needs Students	JCF	\$2,116.00	The purpose of this grant is to provide safe transportation during community based instruction opportunities for Early Childhood Special Education students.
